Vote-By-Mail (VBM) ballots must be emailed or handed to the Regional Director responsible for the Special Election Endorsing Caucus vote in the relevant district. **ONCE RECEIVED BY THE REGIONAL DIRECTOR, YOU MAY NOT RETRACT, RESCIND, OR OTHERWISE CHANGE YOUR VOTE.** It is the voter's responsibility to make sure the VBM ballot is signed by the voter and received by the Regional Director prior to the close of balloting. **YOU MAY ONLY VOTE FOR ONE CANDIDATE PER BALLOT.** If you choose to scan and email your VBM ballot, please scan and email the ballot to Regional Director Larry Gross at larry_gross@icloud.com. The VBM ballot sent email must be received by the Regional Director by 12 a.m. the morning of Thursday, January 18, 2018.

CDP By-Laws, Art. IV, Sec. 7, b, states: In order to vote, and have one's vote counted, at any meeting of This Committee, a member must have timely: (1) paid their dues to This Committee, or had them waived, (2) registered for the meeting, if registration was required, (3) obtained their credential prior to the closing of credentialing, if credentials were issued for the meeting, and (4) completed and returned to the proper authority any ballot that may be issued.
